He writes a column in the ET professional and is widely published. Russell is truly an international speaker, having worked in over 40 countries around the world.

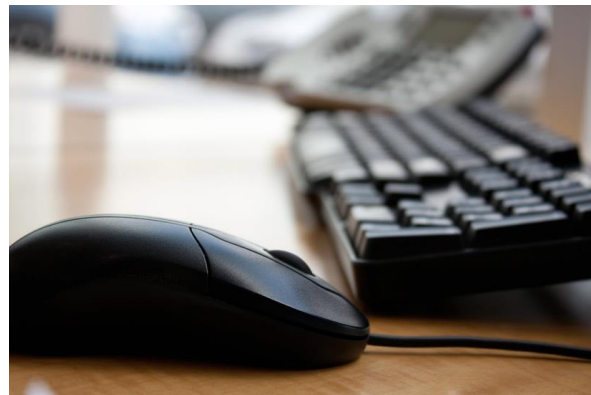

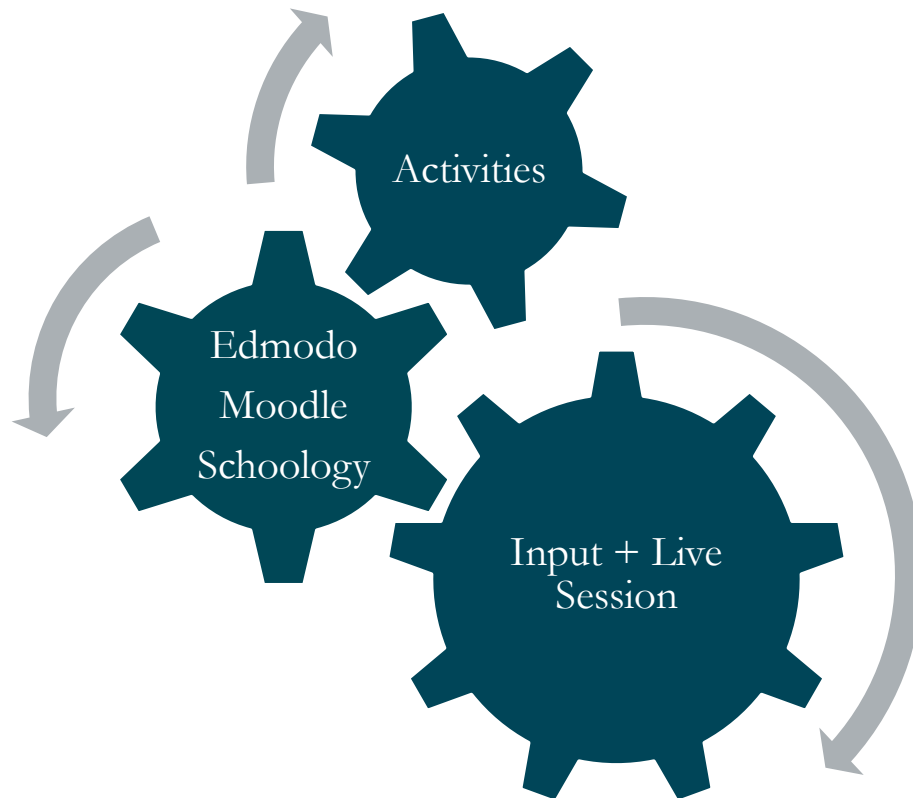

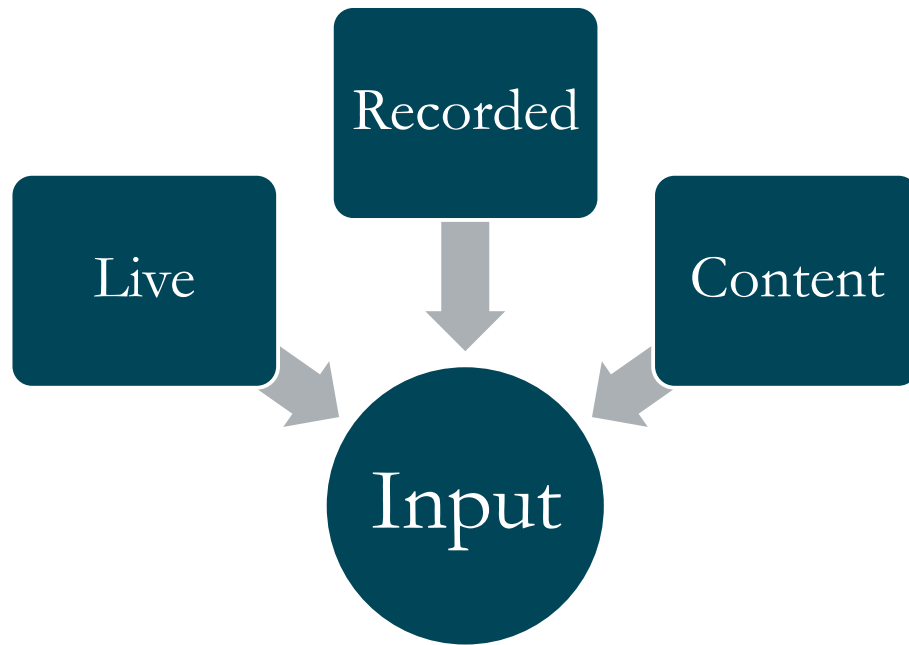
