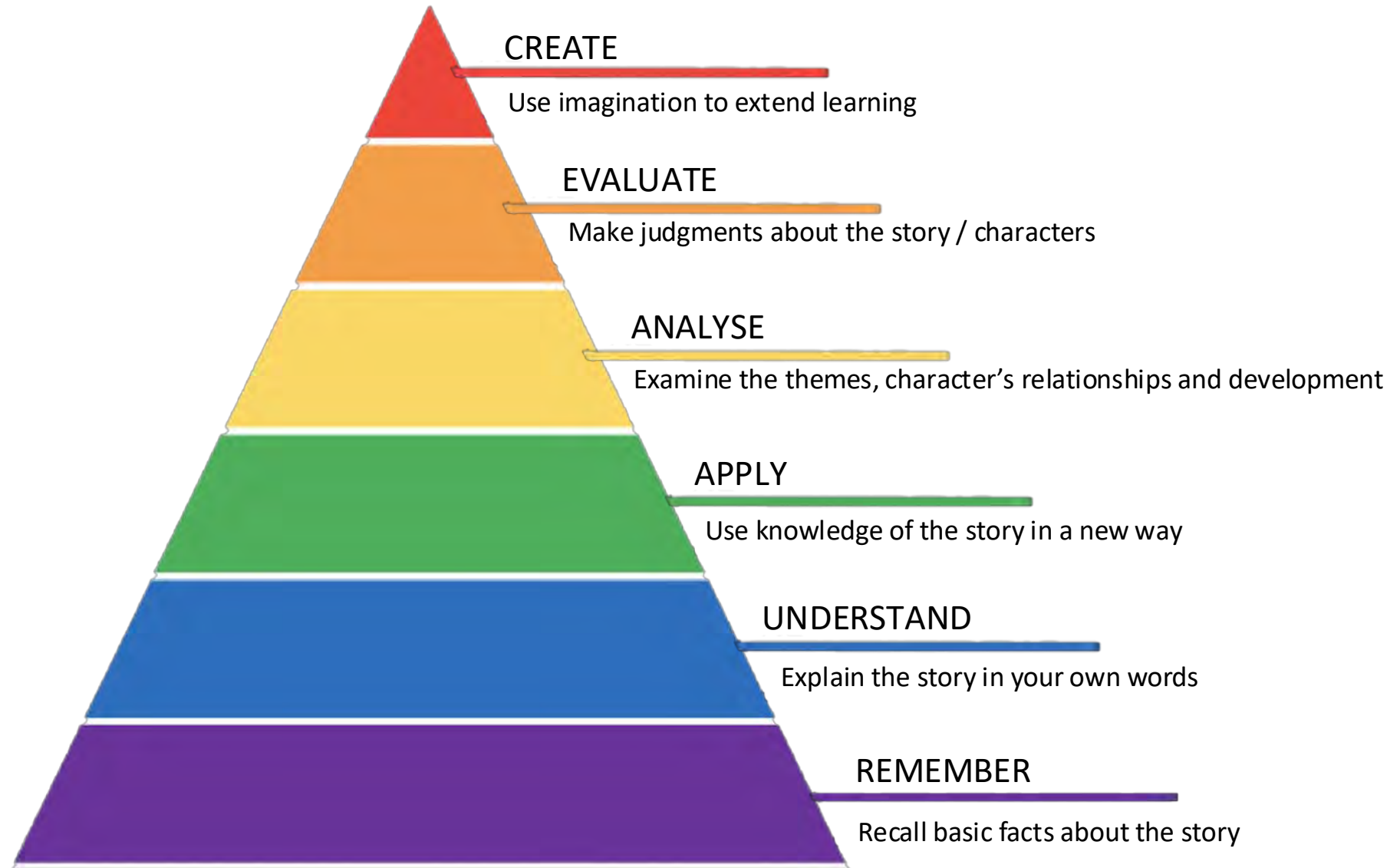

Bloom's Taxonomy - Cognitive Domain (2001)



Limited Engagement with the Story 🙄

Students find it hard to stay engaged with reading, leading to poor recall and understanding.

Difficulty Retaining Key Details 😞

Students struggle to remember characters, plot points, or important details over time.

Imagination & Curiosity Activation 🙄

Help students actively engage with the story rather than passively absorb it.

Remember

Interactive & Multi-Sensory Activities ✨

Engaging different senses reinforces memory.

Repetition & Retrieval Practice 📅

Implement spaced repetition by revisiting key facts over time

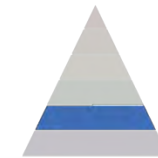

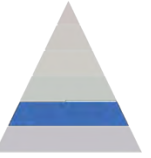

Social changes

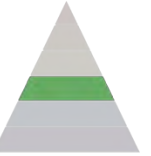

Struggling to Form Opinions 🙄

Students can find it difficult to express their opinions or justify their judgments about the story and characters.

Anonymous Opinion Sharing 👤

Allow students to **share their opinions anonymously** (e.g., writing responses on slips of paper)

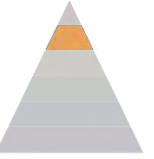
Evaluate

Perspective-Taking & Debate 🙋

Have students **defend or challenge opinions** by arguing from different character perspectives

Opinion Spectrum Statements 📊

Present students with a series of **statements** about the story. Students then respond with "Strongly Agree, Agree, Disagree, Strongly Disagree" and explain why.



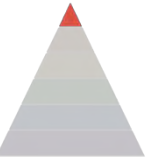

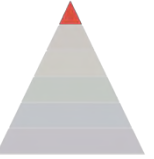

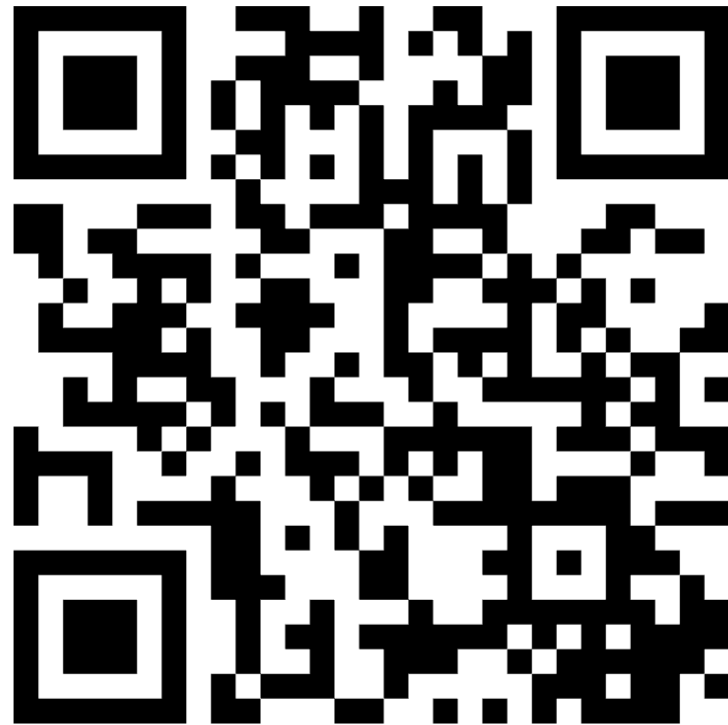
